- Letter of reference from your current employer (if employed) documenting your experience and duties
- Detailed Company Profile if Self Employed
- Documentation of education as stated in your membership application (photocopy/scan)
- Certificate showing proof of Errors & Omissions Insurance
- Submit one Phase I ESA report to CSA Z768 Standards for review (may submit two reports for an additional fee)

Once you have been awarded the designation C.E.S.A. You are required to keep your membership current and agree to abide by any rules and regulations, code of ethics, etc. that may be imposed by AESAC
